Cookie Policy

This Cookie Policy explains how StableSync LLC d/b/a Barnflow (“Barnflow,” “we,” “us,” or “our”) uses cookies and similar technologies on the Barnflow website and application (the “Service”). This policy should be read together with our Privacy Policy.

1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website or use an application. They are widely used to make websites work more efficiently, remember preferences, and provide information to the site owners. Similar technologies include local storage, session storage, pixels, and software development kits (SDKs).

2. How We Use Cookies

We use cookies and similar technologies for the following purposes:

Strictly Necessary Cookies

These are essential for the Service to function. They enable core features such as authentication, security, load balancing, and remembering your session. The Service cannot operate properly without these. Examples include session identifiers and CSRF protection tokens.

Functional / Preference Cookies

These allow the Service to remember choices you make (such as language, display preferences, or previously entered form data) and provide enhanced, more personal features.

Analytics and Performance Cookies

These help us understand how visitors interact with the Service by collecting aggregated information about pages visited, features used, and technical performance. We use this information to improve the Service. Analytics data is typically aggregated or de-identified.

Security and Fraud Prevention

Certain cookies help us detect suspicious activity, protect accounts, and maintain the security of the Service.

3. Cookies We Use

The specific cookies in use may change over time as we update the Service. Categories typically include:

- Authentication and session cookies (necessary to keep you logged in);
- Security cookies (to protect against cross-site request forgery and similar threats);
- Preference cookies (to remember UI settings);
- Analytics cookies (to measure usage and performance);
- Payment-related cookies set by Stripe during checkout flows.

4. Third-Party Cookies

Some cookies are set by third parties that provide services on our behalf, such as payment processing (Stripe), analytics providers, or infrastructure partners. These third parties may use cookies in accordance with their own privacy and cookie policies. We encourage you to review those policies.

5. Managing Cookies

Most web browsers allow you to control cookies through their settings. You can typically set your browser to refuse cookies, delete existing cookies, or notify you when cookies are being set. Please note that blocking or deleting strictly necessary cookies may prevent you from using certain features of the Service, including logging in.

Browser help pages generally explain how to manage cookies for Chrome, Firefox, Safari, Edge, and other common browsers. You may also use industry opt-out tools for certain analytics or advertising cookies where available.

6. Local Storage and Similar Technologies

In addition to cookies, the Service may use browser local storage or session storage to store preferences, temporary data, or offline-capable information (particularly relevant for Progressive Web App functionality used in barn environments). These technologies serve similar purposes to cookies and can usually be cleared through browser settings.

7. Changes to This Cookie Policy

We may update this Cookie Policy from time to time to reflect changes in technology, law, or our practices. We will post the revised policy and update the effective date. Continued use of the Service after changes become effective constitutes acceptance of the revised policy.
